## Literacy:

- 75% of 4K students will be able to identify 15 or more lowercase letter sounds, as evidenced on the letter identification/sound assessment.
- 75% of K-5 students at grade-level will demonstrate one year or greater than one year's growth from fall baseline (spring 2022 independent level) or meet EOY grade level expectations in their highest instructional reading level as measured by BAS.
- 75% of K-5 students below grade level will demonstrate greater than one year's growth from fall baseline or meet EOY grade level expectations in their highest independent reading level as measured by running records.

## Math:

- 80% of 4K students will identify numbers 0-10 by name.
- 50% of K-5 students who took the beginning of the year benchmark assessment will demonstrate proficiency on the End of Year Assessment. The percentage of students that scored in strategic and intensive on the beginning of the year assessment will decrease from 33% to 25% on the end of year assessment.

## **Engagement:**

- Families: Each grade hosts one <u>event</u> per year. Families would attend a minimum of 2 events and parent teacher conferences.
- One time per year we will invite families to participate in an activity in the Makerspace centered around math and/or literacy.
- Students: Increase the school belonging score on the MRA from 72% to 85%
- Behavior: Decrease the gap between behavior referrals for our black and hispanic students.
- Each grade will participate in at least one event (aligned with the curriculum) in the Makerspace activity per month.
